

# Walking/Hiking Club Outings

2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesdays of every month. Pre-registration not required. Participants should be physically fit and prepared for trails with at least some rocky and/or uneven surfaces. Wear sunscreen, a hat, and sturdy shoes with closed-toe & good tread. Bring plenty of water. No pets. Rain or fire cancels.

## Hiking Trails near Happy Camp

Wednesday, February 28, 2024 9-11 a.m.

3 mile round trip. About 400' elev gain/loss.

In hills west of Happy Camp Canyon and Rustic Canyon Golf Course, explore trails across the rolling grasslands.



Meet at Happy Camp upper parking lot From Moorpark Civic Center:

Drive north on Walnut Canyon Road (Highway 23) 2.1 miles.

Turn right (east) on Broadway Road 0.3 miles to dirt parking lot at end.

*Caution: Enter parking lot slowly as it may be heavily rutted from recent rain.*

**Autumn Ridge to Woodridge Loop** Wed, Mar 13, 2024 9-11 a.m.

4 mile loop with about 450' elevation gain/loss

From a Thousand Oaks neighborhood trail-entrance, hike into Lang Ranch open space and to a trail encircling the Woodridge housing development.

Meet at Autumn Ridge trail entrance. From 23 freeway:

Drive east on Ave de los Arboles 1.6 miles

Left on Westlake Blvd 0.7 mile to 'T' intersection at Autumn Ridge.

Park on street. Avoid parking in front of homes if possible.

**Hill Canyon to Wildwood via New Bridge** Wed, Mar 27, 2024 9-11:30 a.m.

5 mile round trip with about 200' elevation gain/loss

Walk from Hill Canyon pedestrian bridge to the new Conejo Canyons Bridge near the water treatment plant. Crossing the arroyo via the new bridge, we will continue into Wildwood Canyon to the campground/picnic area. Return is by way of same trails.

Meet at Hill Canyon Bridge From Tierra Rejada & Moorpark Road intersection:

Drive south on Moorpark Rd 1.4 mile. Right (west) on Santa Rosa Rd 3.7 miles.

Left (south) on Hill Canyon Road ½ mile. Use parking area on the left.

**Western Los Robles Trail** Wed, Apr 10, 2024 9-11 a.m.

Moderate 3 mile hike. About 500' elevation gain/loss.

From a Newbury Park neighborhood, a connector trail ascends to Los Robles Trail. This westernmost section of Los Robles Trail is single-track with numerous ups & downs as it traverses the chaparral above Newbury Park and ends near Wendy & Potrero Road overlooking Rancho Sierra Vista. Return is by way of same trails.

Meet at neighborhood trail access point From 101 freeway in Thousand Oaks:

Drive southwest on Lynn Road 3.2 miles. Left on Felton Street 0.1 mile to end.

Park on street. Avoid parking in front of homes if possible.
