- B. Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting Presentation Recap
  - i. Recreation Coordinator I, Hilary Kleiman, thanked Teen Council members, Katelyn Craft, Bianca Gagajena, and Gauransh Tyagi for presenting at the Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting on April 7. Teen Council and Social Issues Ad Hoc member, Bianca Gagajena, shared that during her presentation, Parks and Recreation Commissioner, June Dubreuil, suggested connecting with the Ventura County Behavioral Health agency to see how Teen Council can support them or vice versa.
