

## **Arts Commission**

### **Duties:**

The Arts Commission meets quarterly in February, May, August and November on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall at 323 Science Drive, and acts in an advisory capacity the City Council. The Commission reviews conceptual design and placement of public artwork, solicits public comment and provides recommendation to the City Council on design and location of artwork. The Arts Commission preforms other duties as may be requested from time to time by the City Council.

### **Term:**

Two-years with an expiration date of December 31 or until a successor is appointed.

### **Appointment:**

Five commissioners appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council.

### **Qualifications:**

Applicants must be a registered voter and must reside within the City limits, City's Area of Interest, the Moorpark Unified School District boundaries or own a business within the City of Moorpark. Boundary Map:

All applicants will be required to attend a regular City Council meeting, typically in December, to make a brief presentation (not to exceed three minutes) on qualifications and interest in the appointment. Use of a PowerPoint presentation will be permitted if the City Clerk has been provided with the file no less than 24 hours prior to the meeting. Failure to make a presentation shall result in disqualification for appointment.

### **Compensation:**

Members of Arts Commission receive compensation for their attendance at each meeting of the Commission as approved by resolution of the City Council. Current compensation for Arts Commissioners is \$50 per meeting not to exceed \$300 per fiscal year.
