



## City of Moorpark Dog Park Rules

### Moorpark Municipal Code (MMC) Section 12.16.200

#### Hours of Operation

Open 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time and 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Savings time. The Dog Park will be closed for maintenance every Wednesday from 7:00 a.m. to 12 p.m.

#### User Age Requirements

No children under 6 years of age are permitted in the Dog Park. Children between 6 and 15 years of age are permitted in the Dog Park with adult supervision.

#### User Assumes All Risk

Use of this facility is a voluntary activity. This facility is not supervised. Users assume all risks and dangers associated with and incidental to this facility. The City of Moorpark will not be held liable for injuries incurred by users or their dogs at this facility.

#### Use Requirements

All Dogs must have a current dog license and must be wearing a collar with a current license tag.

All dogs must be healthy, parasite free, with no contagious conditions, and vaccinated.

Potentially dangerous dogs, vicious dogs, female dogs in heat, and puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited from entering the Dog Park. Dogs exhibiting threatening or aggressive behavior must be immediately removed from the Dog Park.

In the event of a dog bite, or other injury caused by a dog, the person having charge, care, custody or control of the dog that caused the injury must provide current license tag information and contact information to the injured party.

Small dogs of 29 pounds or less shall be restricted to use of the small dog area of the Dog Park.

Large Dogs of 30 pounds or more shall be restricted to use of large dog area of the Dog Park.

Dogs shall be taken off leash in the double gated holding area at the Dog Park entrance. Dogs shall be off leash once inside the fenced area of the Dog Park. All persons owning or having charge, care, custody or control of any dog in the Dog Park must carry a leash.

A maximum of 4 dogs per person 16 years of age or older shall be allowed inside the Dog Park at any one time. Dogs shall not be left unattended in the Dog Park, and close supervision of all dogs is required.

All persons bringing a dog into the Dog Park shall be responsible for cleaning up after their dog, disposing of dog feces in the designated dog waste receptacles, and filling and repairing holes dug by their dog.

All human and dog food, including food products, are prohibited.

Use of noise amplification equipment is prohibited.

Commercial use of the Dog Park is prohibited.

Private rental of the Dog Park is prohibited.

No private equipment, attraction, or structure may be brought into the Dog Park.

#### Dog Park Conditions

City reserves the right to close the Dog Park for any reason, including City sponsored programs.

All other City Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations apply and shall be enforced.

Violations are subject to a citation in accordance with MMC Section 1.10.020
