




Moorpark Unified School District Trustee Areas Map

Welcome!

When you received our last newsletter, we were just a couple months into this COVID-19 pandemic, and we were all still in a state of triage and rapid response, focused on maintaining fully operational police, emergency, and medical response services. As we now come up on five months of living under pandemic conditions, we have retooled our service delivery model, building permitting and inspections have come on-line, potholes are being filled, and graffiti is being removed.

During these months, we created and received over 1,000 subscribers to our M-Powered Economic Development E-Newsletter (moorparkca.gov/MPowered) to keep our business community informed through the pandemic and beyond; re-opened City Hall with new safety precautions and appointment-only hours from 8A-4P so customers do not have to face crowds or wait in lines; created a new, free permit for Moorpark restaurants, salons, dance schools, and martial arts schools to expand on sidewalks and into parking lots to help them recover lost opportunities when indoor operations were prohibited; helped fund the Ventura County Business Assistance Grant Program to provide Moorpark businesses with additional opportunities to receive \$5,000 grants; followed our successful Easter Bunny parade through town with a Fourth of July Porch & Patio Party, special deals from Moorpark restaurants, and a vintage plane flyover; and swapped out most of our streetlight fixtures with more energy-efficient LED fixtures that save taxpayers a whopping \$160,000 annually in electricity costs.

While we have been able to address some of the pandemic's impacts, the reality is that the economic destruction caused by the COVID-19 pandemic cannot be fully mitigated. Economic cycles affect businesses and extend to the City. Diminished retail and employment activity translates to lower sales tax revenues to fund City services.

The difficult task before us now is to cut millions of dollars in spending while still providing our core services. Without having to close any parks, we can still reduce maintenance costs by watering and fertilizing less. Plants won't die, but they will be stressed, which will mean more brown spots in our parks and fewer flowers along our streets. You will see fewer or scaled-down free events and programs that we normally enjoy every year. Seniors receiving home meal delivery services may only see us every few days (but carrying more meals) instead of every day. Less driving also means less gas tax collected, which means a little more time between road resurfacings. In short, the unavoidable reality is that there will be some noticeable differences in our community as we emerge from the shadows of COVID-19. But, I want all Moorparkians to know that City staff is working thoughtfully, creatively, and responsively to make sure that *Life Can Stay This Good in Moorpark*.

STREETLIGHT CONVERSION UPDATE

The City of Moorpark began the process of converting the City's high pressure sodium (HPS) lights to light emitting diode (LED) lights on June 9th, and that work is now almost complete. The new 3000K LED lights are dark sky compliant and are consistent with the American Medical Association's guidelines for ensuring good sleep and driver safety.

In addition to the 2,318 light fixtures on 2,184 light poles, the City is planning to convert 45 decorative lights on High Street to LED later this year.

The City purchased the lights from Southern California Edison in 2019 with the idea of converting the streetlights from HPS to LED. The purchase and conversion are expected to reduce the City's streetlight costs by \$69 per light/per year - that's a savings of over \$160,000 per year!




DISTRICT ELECTIONS ARE COMING TO MOORPARK

This year's November 3rd election for Mayor and two Councilmembers will be a little different for Moorpark. After a threat of litigation to revise our "at-large" election system (where any candidate could live anywhere in the City), the City Council adopted an ordinance in 2018 to transition to a district-based election system beginning with the November 2020 election.

Moorpark now has four City Council districts as shown on the Council District Map. Candidates must be registered voters and live in the district they will represent. City Councilmembers are elected to four-year terms by district starting with the November 2020 election. District elections are staggered every two years. The Mayor continues to be elected at-large with a two-year term.

The first district elections are for Districts 2 and 4 in 2020, and Districts 1 and 3 will hold elections in 2022. You can check which City Council District you live in online at www.moorparkca.gov/election or by calling (805) 517-6223.

RECENT PROJECTS: In addition to the election, we are currently launching an Agenda Management System to make City Council Agenda Report preparation much, much easier, allowing staff to focus time on providing services to the City's residents. Another exciting project in process will help increase the availability and access to documents for both staff members and members of the general public through the City's website.

BEST PART OF THE JOB: The municipal elections process! I greatly enjoy assisting individuals seeking to run for publicly elected office, and helping candidates navigate through the nomination and campaign finance processes because I get to help foster the democratic process that is the cornerstone of our country. It is easy to forget how important the right and privilege to vote is and lose sight of the fact that there are citizens in other countries who don't receive the same rights and privileges. Many people have fought and died for the right to vote (and the other freedoms we enjoy), and my role as an elections official allows me to honor the sacrifice of those who have given all to support and defend our rights.




