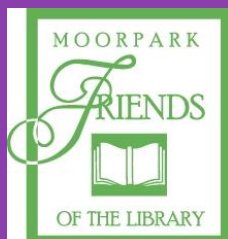

Reading Buddies:

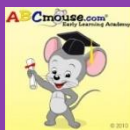
June 18 - August 13 from 10am - 12pm

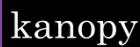
